**We offer ONE stop confidential, non-judgmental integrated contraception and sexual health service.**

**We offer an appointment and walk-in service.**

- Limited walk in is offered at St Ann's Integrated Contraception & Sexual Health Clinic.
- We offer screening and treatment for all types of sexually transmitted infections (STIs) at St Ann's CaSH Clinic.
- Asymptomatic screening (having no symptoms) for sexually transmitted infections is available at all other CaSH Clinics.
- We provide information to women to make an informed choice about contraception methods, including Long Acting Reversible Contraception (LARC).
- We provide emergency contraception, supply condoms and lube.
- We have two dedicated walk in clinics weekly for Young People under 25. C Card scheme registration is available to under 25, for information visit [www.comecorrect.org.uk](http://www.comecorrect.org.uk)
- Our outreach Community HIV Nurse Specialist supports HIV patients living in the community

- We provide implant, depo and coil procedures for all ages; we ONLY provide contraceptive pills for women under 25.
